**Notice to "Under the Roof" Givers:** If you are donating to the Capital Campaign/Under the Roof and you are paying by check please use separate checks for your regular donations and those specifically for the Capital Campaign. All checks should still be made payable to Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd but we have set up a separate bank account for the Capital Campaign so that all monies can be kept separate.

**Under the Roof Campaign News – Other ways to give:** Good Shepherd has opened a brokerage account for individuals who wish to give publically traded securities, bonds and mutual funds to the Under the Roof Campaign. You can transfer appreciated securities, bonds and mutual funds and receive a charitable deduction for the average value of the security on the date the gift was made. Via a gift of appreciated securities or bonds you can avoid paying taxes on short term gains or capital gain taxes (if you owned the securities for more than one year). If your charitable deduction exceeds 30% of your adjusted gross income you can carry the excess forward for five years. Person in the 39.6% tax bracket pay a 20% capital gain rate and persons in the 10-15% tax bracket pay no capital gain taxes. Please consult with your tax accountant with questions or concerns.
