The largest living organism in the world is *Pando* also referred to as the *Sleeping Giant.* Above ground, Pando appears to be a grove of individual Aspen trees, like any other grove. It was overlooked, for years, but underground everything is connected by a single and vast root system. It is <u>one</u> tree. A one-tree-

forest. Located in Utah, Pando is made up of more than 47,000 trunks and millions of leaves. While we are each a new creation, like Pando we share common roots. We are connected to each other through the community of the church. Through fellowship, faith formation and service we come to know each other's stories as we share common tasks.

Financial Update - September 2023

Receipts: Total Current Receipts through September 2023 were up (+1.5%) compared to the same period in 2022. Adult Receipts (pledged giving) was down (-0.9%). Other Adult Receipts were up (+71.1%). Hall Donations/Rental Fees were up (+7.0%). Mortgage Receipts were down (-41.4%).

Expenses: Total Current Expenses through September 2023 increased by (+22.5%) compared to the same period in 2022. The largest portions of the increased expenses were due to Staff salaries and Property maintenance.


